At the January 13, 2017 meeting of the Statewide Health Coordinating Council (SHCC), the SHCC adopted the attached adjustment pursuant to Section 410-2-4-.04(2)(e) of the 2014-2017 Alabama State Health Plan. This proposed adjustment allows for the addition of thirty (30) specialty care assisted living facility (SCALF) beds in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama.

This adjustment was processed in accordance with the *State Health Plan* Rule 410-2-5-.04(4)(d) of the *State Health Plan* provides that a plan adjustment shall be deemed disapproved by the Governor if not acted upon within fifteen (15) days. Upon your approval, the adjustment will be added to the Statistical Update for Section 410-2-4-.04 of the *2014-2017 Alabama State Health Plan*.

State Health Plan Adjustment for Tuscaloosa County, Alabama pursuant to Alabama Admin Code 410-2-4-.04 Limited Care Facilities – Specialty Care Assisted Living Facilities

On January 13, 2017, the SHCC approved an adjustment adding thirty specialty care assisted living facility beds in Tuscaloosa County through conversion of assisted living facility beds for location in a multi-level senior living community defined as providing existing licensed specialty care assisted living facility beds, existing licensed assisted living facility beds and existing independent living residences on a contiguous campus under the same ownership and same management.
