\* Section 410-2-4-.11 (4)(d)3 of the 2014-2017 Alabama State Health Plan states "No CON shall be granted for a new methadone treatment facility to be located within fifty (50) linear miles of an existing treatment facility." Based on the map published as part of this update, applications for a new provider in Region III shall only be considered in those areas of Chambers, Lee, Russell, Dallas, or Wilcox Counties that do not fall within a 50 mile linear distance of an existing facility.
