Such rulings shall be issued provided:
 - (a) the petitioner makes his request pursuant to Rule 410-1-3-.09 no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the regularly scheduled meeting of the CON Review Board, accompanied by a fee of \$1,00150.00. The required filing fee must be submitted to the State Agency via overnight mail and marked in such a way as to clearly identify the fee with the electronic submission; or the fee maybe submitted electronically via the payment portal available through the State Agency's website; and
 - (b) the petitioner shows that he is substantially affected by the rule in question; and
 - (c) sufficient facts are supplied in the request to permit the Certificate of Need Review Board to make a valid determination; and
 - (d) the request arises from an actual question or controversy.
