Re: Request for Reviewability Determination

Andalusia Regional Hospital (Andalusia, Alabama)

Dear Mr. Lambert:

The purpose of this letter is to request your determination, pursuant to Section 401-1-7-.02 of the Alabama Certificate of Need Program Rules & Regulations ("Regulations"), that Andalusia Regional Hospital's addition of a laboratory unit on its campus to house a diagnostic cardiac catheterization program does not require a Certificate of Need ("CON") from the State Health Planning and Development Agency. In order to assist with this determination, we offer the following information:

Andalusia Regional is a rural hospital with eighty-eight (88) licensed beds in Covington County, Alabama. Andalusia Regional proposes to establish a diagnostic cardiac catheterization program and operate this program within a modular laboratory unit located on the hospital campus. The diagnostic cardiac catheterization program will be staffed by experienced and trained personnel in the area of cardiology services, including professional laboratory programs. In addition to housing the diagnostic cardiac catheterization program, the laboratory unit will provide additional space for procedures currently performed in the hospital's operating room, including, but not limited to, other cardiovascular and interventional radiology procedures. The addition of the proposed laboratory unit to Andalusia Regional's campus will provide flexibility in scheduling of procedures currently offered to patients by providing expanded options for procedure room space.

The scope of the proposed project will not exceed any of the CON expenditure thresholds specified in Alabama Code Section 22-21-263(a)(2) and Section 410-1-2-.07 of the Regulations, of \$2,854,550 for major medical equipment, of \$1,141,819 for new annual operation costs, or of \$5,709,099 for capital expenditures, as currently adjusted for CPI. Andalusia Regional estimates that the proposed project will involve the following approximate costs:

The proposed project will not involve the addition of any inpatient beds or the conversion of one classification of beds into another classification of beds. Because Andalusia Regional is a rural hospital, Andalusia Regional is exempt from the CON requirement for new services, as set forth in Ala. Code section 22-21-263(a)(4).²

Accordingly, based on the above, we respectfully request your determination that Andalusia Regional is not required to obtain a CON in order to complete the proposed project. We appreciate your consideration of this request, and welcome the opportunity to address any questions regarding this matter.
