Request for Reviewability Determination

The Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama for the University of Alabama Hospital

UAB Hospital – Highlands, 1st Floor Provider-Based Rehabilitation Gym

Ms. Marsal:

Pursuant to Alabama Certificate of Need Rules and Regulations, "CON Rules") 410-1-7-.02, The Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama for the University of Alabama Hospital ("Board") respectfully requests your review and determination that the Board <u>does not require</u> a Certificate of Need ("CON") from the State Health Planning and Development Agency to initiate and complete the renovation of the 1st Floor of UAB Hospital – Highlands to accommodate a Provider-Based Rehabilitation Gym ("UAB Hospital – Highlands Provider-Based Gym").¹ To complete your review, the Board submits the following information:

The Board is designating a portion of the 1st Floor at UAB Hospital – Highlands as a provider-base department. Currently, the space is utilized for outpatient rehabilitation services. The project will make changes to the space that are necessary to meet the 2014 GF1 Guidelines for Design and Construction of Hospital and Outpatient Facilities and improve the overall functionality. The provider-based rehabilitation area will include a large gym with exercise equipment, ten (10) curtained treatment spaces, an enclosed Concussion Room, a patient bathroom, and two (2) staff work areas. Renovation to adjacent staff offices, support spaces, and the current physical therapy waiting room is also included in the proposed project. The construction budget for the project is \$3,548,000. There will be \$75,000 of new equipment planned for the space, and First Year Annual Operating Costs are projected to be \$1,282,559.

The proposed construction will not exceed any of the CON expenditure thresholds as set forth in CON Rule 410-1-2-.07, which, effective October 1, 2023, are \$3,322,582 for major medical equipment; \$1,327,734 for new annual operating costs; and \$6,638,679 for other capital expenditures.

¹ The University of Alabama Hospital, an academic medical center and the largest hospital in the State of Alabama, is a division of the Board. The hospital is comprised of two acute care hospitals: University Hospital (the main hospital) and UAB Hospital – Highlands, and located within a few blocks of each other in Birmingham, Alabama. Together, the hospitals comprise the University of Alabama at Birmingham ("UAB") Hospital Campus. The hospitals operate under the <u>same</u> SHPDA ID number, under <u>one</u> Tax ID number, under <u>one</u> Medicare and Medicaid provider number, and under <u>one</u> hospital license (H3717) issued by the Alabama Department of Public Health.

The Board submits this request due to a recent change in policy at the Alabama Department of Public Health ("ADPH"), which now requires either a Certificate of Need or a Letter of Non-Reviewability for all construction projects if those projects result in a facility renovation or modification, which triggers a Life Safety Inspection. The UAB Hospital — Highlands Provider-Based Gym will trigger an ADPH Life Safety Inspection. However, the proposed project will result in neither an increase in the number of licensed inpatient hospital beds nor will the project result in a reclassification of beds. No new institutional health services will be offered because of the construction project, and the hospital's existing medical service area, which is comprised of Jefferson, Blount, St. Clair, Walker, Shelby, Bibb, and Chilton counties, will remain the same. Additionally, the UAB Hospital — Highlands Provider-Based Gym project meets the criteria specified in CON r. 410-1-4-.01(1)(j).

We respectfully request your determination that the UAB Hospital – Highlands Provider-Based Gym project is not subject to CON Review and is not required to obtain a CON. The \$1,000.00 filing fee has been submitted electronically. A copy of the confirmation of payment is attached.

In accordance with Ala. Admin. Code r. § 410-1-2-.03, the health service area for the UAB Hospital- Highlands, 1st Floor project is Jefferson County.
