WHAT IS THE SHPDA REVIEW?

The SHPDA Review is a monthly newsletter published by the Alabama State Health Planning and Development Agency.

WHAT INFORMATION IS CONTAINED IN THE SHPDA REVIEW?

The SHPDA Review provides information regarding many of the activities of SHPDA from the previous month. This information includes, at a minimum, letters of intent and project applications received; requests for equipment replacement; changes of ownerships filed; requests for letters of non-reviewability; actions of the Certificate of Need Review Board; certificates of need issued; status of pending projects awaiting certificate of need issuance; status of healthcare provider data; and a calendar of upcoming meetings and events. Additional public notices and information are also included as available.

HOW CAN I OBTAIN A SUBSCRIPTION TO THE SHPDA REVIEW?

Subscription request forms are available from our website at www.shpda.alabama.gov or by contacting our office at (334) 242-4103.

IS THERE ANY COST FOR RECEIVING THE SHPDA REVIEW?

An annual subscription is only \$180 for a printed report. The subscription runs twelve months from the date the request is processed. A subscription to an electronic version of the Review is available for \$90 annually.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO PROCESS MY REQUEST?

You will receive the SHPDA Review the month following receipt of the subscription request form and payment if submitted by the 20th of the month. Subscription request forms and payments submitted after the 20th of the month will result in a two month delay. The SHPDA Review is mailed the last working day of each month.

CAN I RECEIVE COPIES OF PAST ISSUES AFTER I BEGIN MY SUBSCRIPTION?

Yes. The cost for individual issues is \$15.00. The request for past issues will need to be made in writing and accompanied by the appropriate fee.
