- D. **AL2014-034, The Health Care Authority for Baptist Health, An Affiliate of UAB Health System d/b/a Baptist Medical Center East, Montgomery, AL:** Proposes to reallocate and renovate a portion of the women and children's beds and services to the second floor and construct a new twenty-six (26) bed post-partum unit, and construct a four (4) bed ICU step-down unit on the first floor. **Opposition: None**
