 - C. <u>AL2016-009, Rehabilitation Hospital of Phenix City, LLC d/b/a Regional</u> <u>Rehabilitation Hospital, Phenix City, AL:</u> Proposes to expand the existing forty-eight (48) licensed bed capacity by adding ten (10) new inpatient rehabilitation beds pursuant to a Plan Adjustment approved for Russell County, Region V, by Governor Bentley. **Opposition: None**

- D. <u>AL2016-010, Bio-Medical Applications of Alabama, Inc. d/b/a Fresenius</u> <u>Medical Care Valley Creek, Selma, AL:</u> Proposes to add six (6) hemodialysis stations to the existing ESRD facility consisting of sixteen (16) stations, for a total of twenty-two (22) stations, pursuant to Chapter 410-2-3-.05(1)(c) the utilization exception set forth in 410-2-3-.05(2) of the *Alabama State Health Plan.* **Opposition: None**
- E. <u>AL2016-011, Bio-Medical Applications of Alabama, Inc. d/b/a Fresenius</u> <u>Medical Care Tallassee, Tallassee, AL:</u> Proposes to expand the existing End Stage Renal Disease Dialysis Treatment Center consisting of ten (10) hemodialysis stations by adding two (2) home training stations.
