A. Contested Case:

AL2019-008, Huntsville Surgery Center, LLC d/b/a Laser Eye Surgery Center, Madison, AL: Proposes to establish a new single specialty ambulatory surgery center, which will include two (2) operating rooms and a procedure room, for the provision of ophthalmic surgical services, including specialized laser and pediatric services. **Opposition: Eye Surgery Center of North Alabama, Inc. filed notice of intervention/opposition and request for contested case hearing. The Administrative Law Judge submitted a Recommended Order of approval.**

The following project was carried over from the December 18, 2019 CONRB meeting, which was cancelled.

- B. AL2019-027, Bio-Medical Applications of Alabama, Inc. d/b/a BMA Langdale, Valley, AL:** Proposes to expand the existing nineteen (19) station End Stage Renal Disease Dialysis Treatment Center through the addition of two (2) in-center hemodialysis stations, to result in a total of twenty-one (21) stations, two (2) of which are isolation stations. **Opposition: None**

- C. **AL2019-029, Cullman Regional Medical Center, Cullman, AL:** Proposes to expand the ER; add nine (9) exam rooms; five (5) behavioral health treatment rooms; reallocate six (6) medical-surgical beds to critical care/intensive care beds and implement an outpatient behavioral health program through new construction. **Opposition: None**
- D. **AL2019-031, Bio-Medical Applications of Alabama, Inc. d/b/a/ Fresenius Mobile Transitional Care and Home Therapies, Mobile, AL:** Proposes to establish a new End Stage Renal Disease facility consisting of twelve (12) in-center hemodialysis stations, one (1) isolation station, and fifteen (15) home training stations. **Opposition: None**
