AL2025-014, Houston County Health Care Authority d/b/a Southeast Health Medical Center, Houston County, AL: Proposes to develop and construct an 85,155 square foot tower addition, the renovation and expansion of the existing emergency department (ED), and the addition of thirty-five (35) inpatient beds pursuant to §410-2-4-.02 Acute Care (Hospitals) Bed Availability Assurance at the existing acute care hospital in Dothan, Houston County, Alabama. Opposition: None

The additional six (6) beds will bring the total number of geriatric psychiatric beds to twenty-six (26). Opposition: Cullman

Regional Medical Center. Request for contested case was filed 6/20/2025. ALJ was assigned 7/8/2025. ALJs recommended order was filed 9/15/2025. No exceptions were filed.
