- A. **AL2026-001, Serenity Senior Care, LLC d/b/a Serenity at Grace Haven Senior Community, Mobile County, AL:** Proposes to convert sixteen (16) existing Assisted Living Facility (ALF) beds to Specialty Care Assisted Living Facility (SCALF) beds and add an additional sixteen (16) SCALF beds to establish a thirty-two (32) bed SCALF facility in Mobile County, Alabama pursuant to the May 19, 2026 Statistical Update to the *Alabama State Health Plan*. **Opposition: None**

- B. **AL2026-007, Bio-Medical Applications of Alabama, Inc. d/b/a Fresenius Medical Care Tranquility, Madison County, AL:** Proposes to expand its existing twenty-one (21) station End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) Dialysis Treatment Center by adding five (5) in-center hemodialysis stations, to be relocated from the recently closed North Alabama Nephrology Center, for a total of twenty-six (26) in-center hemodialysis stations in Madison County, Alabama. **Opposition: None**

- C. **AL2026-008, Bio-Medical Applications of Alabama, Inc. d/b/a Fresenius Medical Care Rocket City, Madison County, AL:** Proposes to expand its existing End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) treatment facility consisting of sixteen (16) in-center hemodialysis stations, including one (1) isolation station, through the addition of one (1) in-center hemodialysis station to be relocated from the recently closed North Alabama Nephrology Center that ceased operations on December 23, 2024, for a total of seventeen (17) stations in the city of Huntsville, Madison County, Alabama. **Opposition: None**

- D. **AL2026-009, Fresenius Medical Care Metro Huntsville, LLC, Madison County, AL:** Proposes to expand its existing twelve (12) station End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) Dialysis Treatment Center by adding five (5) in-center hemodialysis stations, to be relocated from the recently closed North Alabama Nephrology Center, for a total of seventeen (17) in-center hemodialysis stations in Madison County, Alabama. **Opposition: None**
- E. **AL2026-014, North Alabama Regional Medical Center Freestanding Emergency Department, Calhoun County, AL:** Proposes to develop an off-site freestanding emergency department (FED) along with an associated independent diagnostic testing facility (IDTF) in Jacksonville, Calhoun County, Alabama. **Opposition: None**
